We provide adjustment counseling for children and adolescents (ages 6-21) with a Chronic Illness(Diabetes) or has sustained a traumatic injury(Brain Injury, Spinal Cord Injury ect)Also can provide case management services for same population coordinate services needed to improve quality of life.

We charge \$110.00 per 50 minute session for individual counseling. \$75.00 per hour for case management services exclusive of any expense. Group therapy is offered at \$50.00 per session with a limit of four patients. Payment is expected at time of service and can be paid by cash, debit card or credit card.

Insurance applications filed with BCBS GA, Aetna, CIGNA, Amerigroup and Peach State are pending. In the meantime patients can pay fees and file for reimbursement. We do accept a sliding scale for fees.

We are open Monday through Thursday 11:00 AM- 5:00 PM . Hours vary for the school year and during the summer months.

Additional Comments:

Insurance contracts should be completed by February or March 2009. I look forward to helping those who are having difficulty emotionally adapting to living with chronic illness or disability.

Patients who do not require counseling may benefit from case management services. I am a Certified Case Manager with over 17 years of experience. Many of those years were spent working with children and adolescents and their families.
